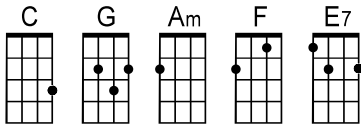


# SOMEWHERE OVER THE RAINBOW/WONDERFUL WORLD

Some [C] day I'll wish upon a star  
[G] Wake up where the clouds are far  
be-[Am]-hind, [F] me ee ee eeh

[C] Somewhere [G] over the rainbow  
[F] Blue birds [C] fly
